KEY PASSAGE(S):

John 14:7-11

Luke 11:2-4

Q: What was something you were afraid of as a kid that might be a little ridiculous as an adult?

Q: What has been your response to this series so far? How have you found it helpful? How have you found it frustrating?

Q: What do you think made John's account of Jesus' life and ministry believable? If his account is reliable, then John 14:7 has huge ramifications.

During the message, Zach said, "if you want to know the father, all you have to do is look at Jesus." Respond to that statement.

Q: If you could know God by listening to Jesus and watching what he does, what are some of the big questions it might answer about who God is and what he thinks of people in general and you specifically?

Q: Read Luke 11:2-4. Is it difficult for you to view God as a perfect father? Why or why not?

Q: Does the idea that God is the perfect reflection of a father, rather than a reflection of your father change the way you see God as Father?

Q: Read 1 John 4:16. How do the circumstances around us affect our ability to show love?

Q: During the message, Zach said, "When it comes to God, Jesus is our best source." What can you do this week to go directly to that source in order to connect with God and discover more about him? What can this group do to help you?

If you could see God just once, wouldn't it settle your fears, give you assurance, and motivate you to hold firm in your faith? If you want to know what God says, listen to Jesus. If you want to know what God is up to, watch Jesus. If you want to have a closer relationship with God, follow Jesus.
