Read Revelation 3:14-22 together.

The church of Laodecia was known for certain things: banking, black wool, eye salve.

Q: Why do you think Jesus said to the church of Laodecia that they needed the very things they were famous for?

Q: How do you think self-reliance makes us lukewarm? Does self-reliance leave room for God?

Read Mark 10:17-22 together.

Q: Where was the faith of the rich young ruler? Was his money the problem? If he had followed Jesus without giving everything else up, where would he have gone if things got tough?

Revelation 3:19 says, "Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline."

Q: Why does the idea of discipline make us uncomfortable?

Read Romans 5:6-8 together.

Q: What are the ways we demonstrate love for the people in our lives? Why do you think sacrifice isn't the first thing that comes to mind?

During the message, Mack said, "You can belong at church before you believe." Is this difficult for you to believe? Why or why not?

Q: What is one thing you can do this week to begin or to continue your adult journey of faith? How can this group support you?
