KEY PASSAGE(S):

Matthew 27:11-31,

Luke 9:57-62,

Matthew 8:18-22

Matt talked about what a "Call to Die" looks like... that it's choosing to follow Jesus the Messiah over choosing to follow yourself. Let's take this deeper in LifeGroups. As we "count the costs," let's look at what following Christ ought to look like.

Q: Who were the "main characters" in this passage of Scripture?

Q: From the question above, describe the choices that each of these people made when answering the question, "Which Jesus are you going to choose?" ...including Jesus the Messiah.

Q: Understanding that we are like Barabbas, sinners replaced by a Savior, how should this change our perspectives and our priorities in life?

There are two passages that are well known for describing the "Cost of Following Jesus". Read Luke 9:57-62 and Matthew 8:18-22 together.

Q: In light of what Jesus has done, what do you think about these passages?

Ultimately, all other relationships in our lives ought to look like hate when compared with our devotion to the Jesus who died in our place. So...

Q: How should this look in our day-to-day lives?

Q: What are some things you can do this week to die to yourself and better submit to Christ?
