SERVICES & ACTIVITIES

EVENING WORSHIP GATHERINGS

MORNING WORSHIP GATHERINGS

CAMP RULES

We feel as though there are boundaries that need to be set in order to create an atmosphere where you can get the most out of camp, and more specifically speaking, a place where you can focus on God alone. For that reason, we do have rules that we ask be followed as well as enforced by your chaperones.

Cell phones

There are times we have determined that the use of cell phones is not recommended in order to promote community and fellowship. **We ask that students leave their phone in the room during activities, games, worship services, and church group times.** You may have them during meals, free time and late night fun.

Curfew

All students and chaperones will need to be in their dorms by 11:30pm. Lights out is 12:00am.

General Rules

- No leaving campus ALONE at any time!
- No alcohol, tobacco, or drugs of any kind permitted anywhere.
- No males in females' rooms at any time and vice versa. No exceptions.
- Absolutely no pranks or any act of vandalism. Students will be responsible for cost of damages.
- Everyone must attend all main services. They are not optional. If a student is caught skipping a service, they will be sent home at the cost of the parent.

STANDARD OF DRESS

Our desire is not to be needlessly legalistic, but we must have a common standard in order to enforce these rules, as well as try to create a distraction-free camp environment.

Females:

1. Shorts should be appropriate length.
2. No spaghetti strap tank tops. (All straps should be at least an inch or two fingers width.)
3. No clothing that reveals the stomach, bra or back. (No midriff, razorback shirts or cleavage.)
4. Leggings may only be worn with shirts that are fingertip length.
5. No offensive slogans or profanity on t-shirts or hats.
6. No two piece bathing suits. (Please wear clothing over bathing suit when walking outside from the beach area.)
7. No pants or shorts with writing across the backside.

Males:

1. No offensive slogans or profanity on t-shirts or hats.
2. Shirts must be worn at all times, except for IN the pool or at the beach. You must wear a shirt to and from the pool and beach.
3. Shorts should be appropriate length (see above).
