## MESSAGE SUMMARY:

In the sermon titled "God" from the series "Unshakeables," Pastor Matt explores the essential beliefs about God that Christians should firmly hold onto. He stresses the non-negotiable beliefs of one God, His sovereignty, role as creator, perfection, eternity, and existence as three distinct persons in the Trinity. Pastor Matt also discusses God as sustainer and redeemer, highlighting His love and redemptive plan through Jesus Christ. This sermon serves as a reminder of the foundational truths that unite Christians and reflect the loving and redemptive nature of God.

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1.) Why is the belief in only one God fundamental to the Christian faith?

Pastor Matt talks about the non-negotiable belief that there is only one true God, which separates Christianity from other religious beliefs.

How does acknowledging the existence of one true God affect your daily life and relationship with Him?

2.) What does it mean for God to be sovereign, and how is this reflected in the concept of the Trinity?

Pastor Matt explains that God has supreme power and control over all things and highlights the Trinity (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) as an example of God's sovereignty.

How does recognizing God's sovereignty influence your trust in His plans for your life?

3.) How do the passages Genesis 1:1 and John 1:3 support the belief that God is the creator of all things?

Pastor Matt cites these passages, which declare that God created the heavens, the earth, and all things were made through Him.

How can you celebrate and appreciate God's creation in your everyday life?

## → DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

4.) What does it mean for God to be perfect, and why is this belief important?

Pastor Matt quotes Deuteronomy 32:4, explaining that God is without fault and does not make mistakes. This belief reminds us of His perfection.

When you encounter difficulties or setbacks, how can remembering God's perfection bring comfort and assurance?

5.) What are the implications of God being a redeemer, and how does this relate to Jesus Christ?

Pastor Matt emphasizes that God loves us and desires to redeem us from our brokenness through His Son, Jesus Christ.

How have you experienced or hope to experience God's redemption in your life, and what steps can you take to strengthen your relationship with Him?
