MESSAGE SUMMARY:

Pastor Matt discusses the essentials of our faith, emphasizing the unshakable beliefs defining us as followers of Christ. He delves into the importance of God's omnipresence in our lives, the real identity of Jesus as the Son of God, and the miraculous nature of His birth to the virgin Mary. Jesus, both fully human and fully God, is portrayed as the one and only Savior whose sinless life and sacrifice offer salvation to believers. The sermon also emphasizes Jesus' resurrection, offering hope for eternal life and summons believers to anticipate His promised return to establish His eternal kingdom.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:
