## → MESSAGE SUMMARY:

In this sermon, Pastor Matt talks about sin, salvation, and the importance of faith in Jesus. Sin originated from Adam and Eve, leading to a sin nature inherited by all. Through Jesus, salvation is offered as a gift from God, received through faith. Salvation involves actions like repenting, believing, confessing, and being baptized, all rooted in faith. After receiving salvation, believers enter a new relationship with God, taking on new responsibilities and relying on Jesus' grace. Pastor urges the congregation to share the Gospel, support each other, and continue their faith journey at ACC.

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

1.) What are some new responsibilities we take on after we are saved?

Pastor Matt talked about our new relationship with God and mentioned living for Christ and sharing the Gospel with others.

3.) What steps can we take to share the Gospel with someone in our life?

Pastor Matt encouraged the congregation to think of one person who needs to hear the Gospel and share it with them.
