> MESSAGE TITLE: The First Steps of the Gospel

MESSAGE DATE: 08/11/2024

MESSAGE SUMMARY:

Pastor Matt's sermon focuses on the gospel cycle in the book of Colossians, stressing the importance of sharing the gospel. Using Colossians 1:3, he emphasizes the need for verbal communication in sharing the good news, challenging the notion that actions alone are sufficient. Through the stages of believing and transforming, Pastor Matt underscores the Holy Spirit's transformative work and the call to love others as Christ does. Lastly, he urges the congregation to actively participate in discipleship and continually share the gospel, embodying the idea of 'beautiful feet' in spreading the message of Christ.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Pastor Matt discusses the difference between knowing about Jesus and truly believing in Him, using the example of St. Francis of Assisi's quote.

How has your belief in Jesus impacted your daily life and decisions?

3.) How does the Holy Spirit bring about transformation in a believer's life, and what role does discipleship play in this process?

What are some areas in your life where you have experienced or desire transformation through the Holy Spirit and discipleship?
