MESSAGE SUMMARY:

Pastor Brian discusses the significance of worship by reflecting on how Jesus worshiped, both publicly and privately, emphasizing a personal and authentic relationship with God. He shares a compelling story about a woman who experienced a revelation of Christ through an ordinary moment, highlighting the deep human desire for meaning and connection. Through exploring scripture, Pastor Brian emphasizes that true worship requires full devotion, authenticity, and a willingness to give oneself entirely to God. Ultimately, he encourages the congregation to examine their own worship practices in light of Jesus' example, seeking to ensure their worship is transformative and grounded in truth.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1.) Why do you think it is important for worship to be based on the truth of Scripture?

In the sermon, Pastor highlighted that Jesus said true worshipers must worship in spirit and truth, emphasizing the significance of Scripture.

Can you think of a time when your understanding of Scripture impacted how you worshiped or saw God in a different light?

2.) What are some ways that you personally express worship in your daily life?

Pastor Brian discussed how worship goes beyond just singing in church and can include actions and attitudes toward God.

Reflect on a recent time when you lessened your commitment to worship—what changed in your attitude or behavior, and how can you address that?

3.) How did the story of the 'Jesus tortilla' illustrate the human desire for hope? What does this say about how we might worship things outside of God?

Pastor shared the story of how many people came to see a tortilla with a scorch mark that resembled Jesus, indicating a deeper spiritual longing.

What are some 'tortillas' in your life that might distract you from truly worshiping God? How can you refocus your worship?
